Classes will be held at the McKendree College Louisville Campus on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 – 11:45 A.M. beginning June 6<sup>th</sup>, ending on June 29<sup>th</sup>. The instructor for this course will be Mr. (Señor) José Luis Alfaro, MBA, MA, a teacher from Male High School and an adjunct professor at McKendree College.

### Requirements:

1. Submit a completed application form by May 24, 2006.
2. Submit a written essay as described below.
3. Student must be bilingual as textbooks and instruction will be delivered in Spanish and English.
4. Student must be between the age of 14 and 18.
5. Student must attend all scheduled class meetings as follows:(June: 6, 8, 13, 15, 20, 22, 27, 29).
6. Each student is required to provide his/her own materials (pencils and spiral notebook).A calculator could be useful but it is not required.
7. A signed, written commitment form is required from the parents/guardians of each student, acknowledging that the scholar will attend all the scheduled classes of the seminar.

### Application Process:

Students may apply via fax or in person at McKendree College.  
A 300-word essay must be submitted (in Spanish or English) describing how a strong knowledge of algebra will help them to achieve success in college and/or in a given career choice, including the importance of parental support in their daily decisions.
